Ordered, by The House of Commons, to be printed,
27 July 1814.

- (1.)—Return to an Order *for* “Copies of Returns made to the Treasury, by the Superintendent of Captured Negroes at Sierra Leone, of the number of Negroes delivered into his charge, for the use of his Majesty,”—&c.
- (2.)—Return to an Order *for* “Copies of the Certificates addressed to the Treasury, signed by the Governor of Sierra Leone, in favour of the Naval Commanders on the Coast of Africa,”—&c.
- (3.)—Return to an Order *for* “Copies from the Treasury, of the Sums of Money drawn for by the Governor of Sierra Leone, on account of Captured Negroes, and how it has been appropriated, to the latest period.”

RETURN to an Order of the Honourable House of Commons,
dated 4th July 1814;—for

Copies of RETURNS made to the Treasury by the Superintendent of CAPTURED NEGROES at *Sierra Leone*, of the number of NEGROES delivered into his charge, for the use of his Majesty; and specifying the number of Men, Women, Boys and Girls, who have been bound out as Servants or Apprentices, with the term of years each is to serve; specifying, what has become of every individual captured Negroe; to the latest period; in conformity to the Act 51 Geo. III.

NO Returns have been made, to the Treasury, by the Superintendent of Captured Negroes at *Sierra Leone*.

RETURN to an Order of the Honourable House of Commons,
dated 4th July 1814;—for

Copies of the CERTIFICATES addressed to the Treasury, signed by the Governor of *Sierra Leone*, in favour of the NAVAL COMMANDERS on the Coast of *Africa*, to claim Bounty for CAPTURED NEGROES; to the latest period; in conformity to the Acts 47 & 51 Geo. III.

NO Certificates, in favour of Naval Commanders, have been received at the Treasury.

RETURN to an Order of the Honourable the House of Commons, dated the 4th July 1814;—requiring, “Copies from the Treasury, of the Sums of Money drawn for by the Governor of *Sierra Leone*, on account of CAPTURED NEGROES, and how it has been appropriated; to the latest period;”—prepared in pursuance of the directions contained in a Treasury Letter, dated the 6th July 1814; and, as far as it can be made out, from the Accounts of the several Governors of Sierra Leone, now in the Audit Office, beginning 1 January 1808, and ending 31 December 1813.
