Copy of a PROCLAMATION issued by Governor AINSLIE, at Dominica, on the 3rd October 1813.

DOMINICA.

BY His Excellency George Robert Ainslie, Esquire, Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over the said Island, Chancellor, Vice Admiral, and Ordinary of the same.

WHEREAS Detachments of His Majesty's Troops have been sent into the Woods, and have discovered the Tracks of the Runaway Camps: AND Whereas I am desirous of affording the misguided Slaves who have absented themselves from the employ of their Owners, an opportunity, before I proceed to extremities, of returning to their duty; I DO, by this my Proclamation, promise a full and unconditional Pardon to all Runaway Slaves, who shall surrender themselves, at the Government House in the Town of Roseau, on or before the twenty-fourth day of this month of October: AND I do further Declare, That the utmost Rigour of Military Execution shall be put in force against all those Runaway Slaves that may be apprehended after that period, neither Age nor Sex spared, all indiscriminately shall be put to the Bayonet. GIVEN under my Hand and Seal at Arms, this third day of October, one thousand eight hundred and thirteen, and in the Fifty-third year of HIS MAJESTY's Reign.
