SLAVES.—AN ACCOUNT OF ALL SUMS

Which have been at any time, under or in pursuance of the Treaties with *Spain, Portugal*, and the in any manner, by Great Britain, to Spain, Portugal, or the Netherlands, respectively;

PORTUGAL.

BY an Act of 49 Geo. 3, c. 71, a Sum of £.600,000 was raised for the Service of Portugal, being a part of the Loan of that Year, and £. 895,522. 7. 9. Three per Cent Stock, was created in respect of the said Loan, and the Portuguese Government engaged to pay, in equal half yearly payments, the Sum of £. 26,865. 13. 5 $\frac{1}{4}$. for Interest, the Sum of £. 30,000 for Sinking Fund, and the Sum of £. 304. 9. 6 $\frac{3}{4}$. for Management upon the said Loan.

Those Payments were regularly made up to the 5th April 1815, when the Sum of £. 601,771. 7. 9. of the original Capital created remained unredeemed.

By the Treaty of 22d January 1815, all further payments from Portugal, in respect of the said Loan, were remitted.
