Copy of a Letter from the Duke of Manchester to Earl Bathurst, K. G. dated
King's House, Jamaica, 12th May 1823;—enclosing Returns of Slaves imported
into and exported from the port of Port Maria, since the 1st January 1808.

MY LORD,

King's House, Jamaica, 12th May 1823.

REFERRING your Lordship to my letter of 17th March,* accompanying
sundry Returns, in compliance with the resolutions of the House of Commons
of 3d August last, I have now the honour to enclose, Copies of Returns of
Slaves imported into and exported from the port of Port Maria, since the
1st of January 1808; which I only received from the custom-house officers on
the 2d instant.
