SLAVES TRANSPORTED.

RETURN to an Address to HIS MAJESTY, dated 18 July 1833;—for,

RETURN of all Orders in Council, and the Dates thereof, with the Names of the Parties, under which SLAVES were TRANSPORTED into *Demerara* from the *Bahamas*, or any other *British Colony*, since the Peace of 1815:—also, a RETURN of the AVERAGE PRICE which SLAVES produced, at Judicial Sales within such respective Colonies, at the period when any Transportation took place.

RETURN of the AVERAGE PRICE which SLAVES produced at Judicial Sales within such respective Colonies, at the period when any Transportation took place.

RETURNS of Judicial Sales of SLAVES were presented to Parliament, on the 4th March 1823, Paper N° 89; and 9 May 1826, N° 353. By these Accounts, it appears that the average Price which Slaves produced at

Demerara,	in 1822,	amounted to	1009 ^s or 77 <i>l.</i> 10 <i>s.</i> 6 <i>d.</i>	per Slave.
Ditto	1823,	ditto	853 ^s or 65 <i>l.</i> 10 <i>s.</i> 6 <i>d.</i>	ditto.
Bahamas,	1823,	ditto	45 <i>l.</i> 17 <i>s.</i> 6 <i>d.</i>	or 25 <i>l.</i> 6 <i>s.</i> 6 <i>d.</i> ditto.

The Returns from *Dominica* do not state the Price of Slaves in that Island; nor from *Demerara* or *Bahamas*, for any other periods than those above stated.
