dated 22 March 1841 ;—for,

A RETURN of the PROCEEDS paid into the REGISTRY of the HIGH COURT of ADMIRALTY, to the 1st day of January 1841, of all VESSELS taken under the late Treaty with *Spain*, and in pursuance of the Act 2 & 3 Vict. ; stating the Period when the same was paid or payable to the Captors ; distinguishing the Nature and Amount of the several Fees paid or payable in each Case :—LIST of all CLAIMS laid before the COMMISSIONERS of HER MAJESTY'S TREASURY, for the several BOUNTIES on TONNAGE, under the Acts of 1 & 2 Vict. c. 47, and 2 & 3 Vict. c. 73 :—also, an ACCOUNT of all VESSELS that have been taken into Her Majesty's Service under the Powers of the last-mentioned Act ; stating the Sums which the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty have deemed a proper Price for the same, to the 1st day of January 1841.
