RETURN to an Address of the Honourable The House of Commons,  
dated 18 July 1840;—*for*,

A RETURN of SLAVE VESSELS brought before the several Courts of Mixed Commission for Adjudication, since the 1st day of January 1839, to the latest Date to which the same can be prepared; distinguishing the Flag under which each Vessel was seized; the Name of the capturing Ship, and the Commander thereof; the Amount of registered Tonnage of each Vessel, as well as the Amount by the old and present Admeasurement, and if Slaves on board, stating the Number at the time of Seizure, and the Date of the decretal part of the Sentence, whether Forfeiture or Restitution, with the Amount of the Proceeds of Sale, as far as the same can be made out, or of Costs awarded; and distinguishing the Expenses of Condemnation and breaking up of each Vessel, and the Proportion remaining for Distribution to the Captors.—(So far as it can be made out at the Foreign Office.)
