RETURN to an Address of the Honourable The House of Commons, dated 3 March 1848;—for,

- "RETURNS of the Number of Vessels Captured by Her Majesty's Squadron on suspicion of being engaged in the Slave Trade, during the Years 1846 and 1847 respectively:"
- "And, of the Number of Slaves Landed at Sierra Leone from Prizes taken by Her Majesty's Ships, and then Liberated, in each of the Years from 1832 to 1847, both inclusive."
