SLAVE TRADE.

RETURNS (so far as the same can be made out at the Foreign Office) to Two Addresses of the Honourable The House of Commons, dated 3 May and 16 June 1842;—for,

- RETURNS of the Number of Vessels which have been adjudicated in the Courts of Mixed Commission at Sierra Leone, from the latest Date included in the Return, No. 8, of the Appendix to the Report of the Committee on the State of that Colony, printed by Order of The House in the Year 1830, down to the latest Period to which the same can be made up; stating the Time and Place of Capture, and the Time that clapsed before the Ship arrived at Sierra Leone for Adjudication; the Number of Slaves on Board at the Time of Capture, and the Number that were landed at Sierra Leone; distinguishing Males from Females, and Adults from Children; so far as the same can be made out:
 - Of the Number of VESSELS of every Class in Her Majesty's Service which have been employed on the WEST AFRICAN STATION in each Year since the Year 1828; specifying the Name, Class, and Force of each, together with the Numbers of their respective Crews; and stating the Number of Deaths in each Vessel in each Year, distinguishing those which have occurred in Action or by Accident—(in part continuation of Return ordered by The House to be printed, 17 February 1830):
 - Of the Total Expense of the Naval Force employed in the Suppression of the Slave Trade on the Western Coast of Africa, in each Year since the first Establishment of the Mixed Commission Courts:
 - Of the several Powers with which TREATIES have hitherto been concluded for the Suppression of the SLAVE TRADE; specifying those which have admitted the "Equipment Article," and the Date of each Ratification.

RETURN of Slave Vessels brought before the several Courts of Mixed Commission, or before any British Vice-Admiralty Court, for Adjudication, between the 1st day of January 1840 and the 31st day of December 1841, with the Name of the capturing Ship and the Commander thereof, describing the Flag under which each Vessel was seized; distinguishing those under the late Treaty with Spain and under the Act 2 & 3 Vict. c. 73, the registered Tonnage of each Vessel, as well as that by British Admeasurement, and if Slaves on Board; stating the Number at the Time of Scizure, the Date of the Decretal Part of the Sentence, whether Forfeiture or Restitution, with the Amount of Proceeds of Sale or of Costs awarded, the Expenses of Condemnation and of breaking up of each Vessel, the Period when the Proceeds for Distribution were paid into the Registry of the High Court of Admiralty, and when the same was paid to the Captors:

Also, Account of all Claims for the several Bounties or Tonnage between the 1st day of January 1840 and the 31st day of December 1841, and of all Slave Vessels that have been taken into Her Majesty's Service, under the Provisions of the Act 2 & 3 Vict. c. 73; stating the appraised or estimated Value of the same, the registered Tonnage, as well as that by British Admeasurement, and the Sums which the Commissioners of the Admiralty have deemed a proper Price for the same.
