RETURN to an Order of the Honourable The House of Commons,
dated 20 May 1857;—for,

A RETURN “of HER MAJESTY’S SHIPS and VESSELS employed on the Coast of Cuba for the SUPPRESSION of the SLAVE TRADE, from the 1st day of January 1854, stating the dates of their Arrival on, and their Departure from their respective Cruising Stations, with the names of their several Captains and Commanders, and distinguishing Steam from Sailing Vessels.”
