NOTES.

The above Return has been prepared from Documents received from the respective Courts of Adjudication, and from the Memorials to the Lords of the Treasury for the Bounties.

The cases are arranged according to the date of capture.

Under the column of "Where Captured" the place of capture is given as nearly as can be ascertained. The letters E. C. and W. C. mean respectively "East Coast of Africa" and "West Coast of Africa." In order to make the Return complete I have added a column for the "Court of Adjudication." Under that column where it is said simply "St. Helena," "Cape of Good Hope," "Aden," &c. it means the Vice Admiralty Courts at those respective places. Where the case has been taken before a Mixed Commission Court it is stated whether it is a "British and Spanish," "British and Portuguese," &c.

The difference between the number of Slaves captured and the number emancipated in any case shows as a general rule the number who have died between the times of Capture and of Condemnation. It will be seen that in several cases where slaves have been Captured and Condemned, no Slave Bounties have been awarded; this arises from the fact that captors have the option of claiming the Bounty of 4 l. a ton on the Tonnage of the Vessel, in lieu of the Bounty of 5 l. a head on the slaves, if they think fit to do so, and they always do, if the former exceeds the latter.

I have no means of supplying the blanks in the column of "Number of Crew of Capturing Ship."
